**FRIDAY UPDATE: 02.16.18-02.23.18**

This week we want to give a shout-out to the Andover resident who called in a suspicious male. The story went something like this:

A male and female were stopped by Asset Protection at Walmart for stealing items. The female stopped but the male ran. He ran to the area of 137 & Vale when he was seen by a resident. The resident called 911 to report the male because he appeared to be watching children getting off a school bus. When deputies arrived in the area, the male matched the description of the man who was involved in the shoplifting incident at Walmart. The suspect attempted to change his appearance by removing certain items of clothing, but he was no match for our observant deputies. He was promptly arrested and taken to jail – all because of an observant Andover resident who wasn't afraid to call 911!
