FRIDAY UPDATE: 03.10.17-03.17.17

Investigator Insight: The patrol division has observed a fair amount of incidents involving theft cases where a victim has had property taken from them that is later recovered by law enforcement. When this occurs it is very helpful for us to learn that their personal items of value can be identified by specific markings and or documented by model and or serial number. When we as law enforcement recover items that we believe to be stolen property, we have to have documentation of not only what can be identifiable as stolen but also who can show proof that they are indeed the rightful owner. In many instances property is collected and is not able to be given back to its rightful owner because either that person has not reported the item as missing and or they are unable to prove that it is in fact their item and not someone else's recovered stolen item. Taking the steps to document your property by photo can also prove to be very helpful in situations such as these.
