FRIDAY UPDATE: 05.05.17-05.12.17

When we read burglary reports, often the thief heads directly to the master bedroom to start looking for your valuables - specifically in closets, under beds, night stands, and dressers. That is where most people keep valuables like guns, jewelry, cash, and prescription drugs.

We reached out to our investigators asking them where they hide their valuables in the house. One investigator was very passionate about telling us not to hide valuables in the obvious places © His response went like this:

"Hide valuables in game boxes in a game room, kid's room, utility area, laundry room, unfinished areas of your home - or in a pantry and place them in an empty food containers. I've never seen a burglar take a box of cereal, coffee can, or Tupperware from a panty or cupboard. Nor have they taken a package marked soup bone from the freezer. I've seen thieves take frozen pizzas and steaks, but it's all about presentation and labeling. Hide things in plain sight and be creative outside of the master bedroom! What criminal is going to open a scrabble game to see what's inside?" You have heard it from an expert.
