FRIDAY UPDATE: 06.30.17-07.07.17

We had three incidents of license plate thefts in two different cities this week. Thieves steal license plates for a variety of reasons: to conduct criminal activity, for doing gas drive-offs, hiding their license status if their plate is run by police, or to obtain current tabs. You can prevent this type of theft by using special screws that require a security wrench to remove them. You can purchase these types of items online by Googling "Plate Safe Locks." It is just one added layer of protection if you are so inclined.
