We want to take the time to remind you to be a responsible gun owner. You should never leave a gun – hunting or otherwise – in a vehicle. A jimmyed door, a broken window, and someone can steal a gun that can now be used to commit more crimes. Harvard did a study last year and found that 1600 guns are stolen every day from vehicles in the US and stolen guns often end up at crime scenes.
