- ✓ Identity theft is the **fastest growing crime** in the United States.
- ✓ Victims report spending an average of **116 hours** repairing the damage done by identity theft.¹
- ✓ 70% of victims take up to **12 months** to repair the damage of identity theft.²
- ✓ 71% of fraud occurs within 7 days of identity theft, yet over 50% of identity theft victims do not learn of the theft within **3 months** of occurrence.³
- ✓ Identity Theft costs its victim **\$4,841¹** in damages per victim.
- ✓ **47%** of Identity theft victims encounter credit problems.
